**Application/Eligibility Form for Title 5 System Inspector**

System Inspectors who perform inspections pursuant to 310 CMR 15.301 shall be: (a) Massachusetts Registered Professional Engineers with a concentration in civil, sanitary or environmental engineering; Massachusetts Registered Sanitarians; or Certified Health Officers; or (b) Board of Health members or agents, Engineers in Training (EIT certified) with a concentration in civil, sanitary, or environmental engineering, professional home inspectors, licensed septage haulers or system installers, or other individuals with a minimum of one year of demonstrated experience in septic system inspection, who have attended training provided or authorized by the Department; and who have passed an examination prepared and administered by the Department or an agent authorized by the Department to qualify as an approved System Inspector pursuant to 310 CMR 15.34-(2).

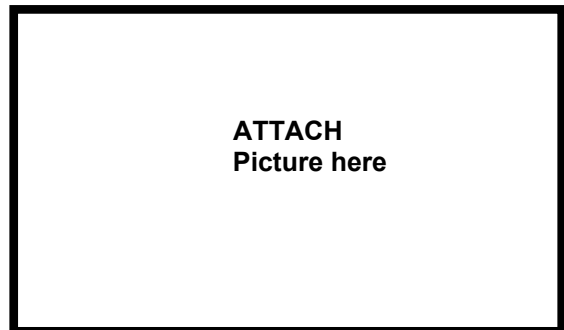

If P.E., R.S., or C.H.O. and applying directly for SI certification without class/exam, a \$95 registration fee payable to NEIWPCC must be included at time of application.

Engineer in Training (EIT certified)	Copy of certifying document and proof of concentration (civil, environmental, or sanitary engineering)

Licensed Septage Hauler	Copy of current license
Licensed Septic System Installers	Copy of town/city permit to install septic systems
Other Individuals	Letterhead correspondence from employer or responsible party verifying qualifying experience (at least one year in septic system inspections)
* Registered Professional Engineer with concentration in <b>civil, sanitary, or environmental</b> engineering (course and examination not required)	Copy of state registration or P.E. stamp
* Certified Health Officers (course and examination not required)	Copy of certification
* Registered Sanitarian (course and examination not required)	Copy of certification

*\* **Note:** Registered Professional Engineers, Certified Health Officers, and Registered Sanitarians are not required to take the course and examination in order to become certified System Inspectors, but must submit a registration fee of \$95 payable to NEIWPC at the time of application.*
